

## **Abstract**

**Subject matter:** Neologisms in the French socio-political formation

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**Topicality of the research:** The study of socio-political neologisms in modern French is relevant because their class is constantly updated and has a significant impact on the development and enrichment of the vocabulary of the French language in contact with other languages and cultures.

**Objectives of the research** the identification and description of word-formation, semantic and functional-stylistic features of French socio-political neologisms of the XXI century, their system analysis and typological generalization.

**Tasks of the research:**

- to analyze the functional environment of the considered socio-political innovations, represented by media (Newspapers, Internet) discourse;
- to classify socio-political lexical innovations selected from the corpus of discursive media sources and electronic dictionaries in accordance with their categorical features;
- to develop a typological matrix for the representation of categorical features of socio-political neologisms of the French language of the XXI century.

**Theoretical and practical significance:** it is an opportunity to re-evaluate the structural and functional features of socio-political neologisms of the French

language of the XXI century, to reveal some features of the sources and pragmatic goals of modern lexical innovations, as well as the practical possibility of using the obtained theoretical and empirical data in an in-depth study of the lexicology of the French language, writing term papers and theses.

**Results of the research** the article analyzes the functional environment of the considered socio-political innovations, represented by media (Newspapers, Internet) discourse; classifies socio-political lexical innovations selected from the corpus of discursive media sources and electronic dictionaries in accordance with their categorical features; develops a typological matrix for the presentation of categorical features of socio-political neologisms of the French language; a dictionary of French socio-political neologisms has been prepared for publication, intended for a wide audience of specialists and students of the French language
