

SUMMARY

Subject matter: Verbal opposition in the French spoken discourse

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Data about the organization - client: Russian Foundation for Humanities (project 14-04-00029 «Cultural and linguopragmatic aspects of parliamentary communication in EU countries (UK, Germany, France. The European Parliament»)

Topicality of the research: is due to the necessity of deepening the development of the problem of a verbal opposition in different genres of French discourse.

The objective of the research: is the analysis of cases of verbal opposition in different genres of French discourse and making a typology of different categories of verbal opposition.

Tasks of the research:

1. To define the concept of verbal opposition in colloquial discourse, as well as to identify the means of its implementation;
2. To analyze the theoretical approaches to the concept of verbal interaction in linguistics and sociolinguistics;
3. To identify and make a typological analysis of the different situations and markers of the verbal opposition in the French discourse of different genres.

Theoretical and practical significance: is to study the verbal opposition markers and their typology, which will help to continue the study of the language markers and give the opportunity to approach an explicit compilation of categorical speech paradigm.

Results of the research: the analysis of cases of verbal opposition in colloquial and institutional discourses shows the immanence of the opposition in different levels of the communications. The typology by the different linguistic markers identified a number of universal features of the verbal opposition.

Recommendations: the results of the study can be used in the practice of the French language, the study of the theory of intercultural communication, linguistics. They can also be used in the development of various teaching methods, courses of French grammar, interpretation and analysis of texts of different genres, the study of stylistics and rhetoric.
