

## SUMMARY

**Subject matter:** Constitutional and legal bases of realization of powers of public authorities of Stavropol territory in the sphere of resort provision of citizens

**The relevance of the research topic** is that the legislation defining the main directions as sanatorium-resort activity, and the sanatorium-resort market of services, completely isn't developed. As a result, the industry system of standardization, certification and licensing has not yet been formed, a unified system of training for the sanatorium complex and their certification has not been established. All these questions allow us to determine the relevance of the studied problems.

**The aim of the research** is the study of legal, theoretical and organizational-legal framework for the implementation of the powers of public authorities in the field of social security of citizens.

**Objectives:**

- to study materials on the history of the development of legislation on tourism in Russia;
- to analyze the legal regulation of Spa activities in the Russian Federation at the present stage;
- to investigate the issues of competence of public authorities and local authorities in the field of tourism;
- to consider actual questions of organizational and legal bases of formation of public authorities in the sphere of resort providing citizens (on the example of Stavropol territory).

**The theoretical and practical significance** consists in the analysis of the legal foundations of the functioning and activities of public authorities and municipalities of the Stavropol territory.

The conclusions and proposals contained in the work can be successfully used:

- in law enforcement activities of state and local governments;
- in educational and cognitive activities, in the course of reading the course "Constitutional law" and "Municipal law" for law students.

**The results obtained:** As a result of the analysis of the current legislation, it can be concluded that at the present stage of the formation of market economy in the health resort business of Russia there are structural changes associated primarily with organizational and managerial aspects, namely: the commercialization of services in this area is growing, the number of private (or collective ownership) institutions is increasing, the number of offers of health resort recreation is increasing. In modern conditions, the development of the Spa complex, the preservation and multiplication of the traditions of domestic balneology, the increase of professional knowledge and skills of specialists in the resort business is one of the most important tasks, which requires the involvement of state authorities. The study showed that the current management mechanism in the country does not allow to solve the main tasks of the Spa complex, as evidenced by the relative decrease in the availability of Spa treatment for the population.
