

SUMMARY

Subject matter: Legal responsibility in the local government system.

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The purpose of the study is to analyze the problems of importance and implementation of the institution of legal responsibility in the system of local self-government.

To achieve this goal, the following tasks are put forward:

- conduct an analysis of legal responsibility as an independent institution of Russian law;
- to study the theoretical and practical aspects of the institution of legal responsibility of local authorities and officials;
- consider current issues of legislative consolidation and qualifications in the framework of legal responsibility in the system of local self-government.

The main barrier to the implementation of the responsibility of local authorities is the flaws in the legislation that governs the institution of responsibility to the population, and the rules defining responsibility to the state are also not sufficiently objective. to this kind of responsibility.
