**Topicality of the research:** to observe and to study linguistic properties of the French

regional language, forming it's language picture of the world.

**Objectives of the research:** to reveal the main peculiarities of the language picture

of the world belonging to the French regional language.

### **Tasks to the research**

- to analyze objective historical and juridical reasons, which affected the language picture of the world of Suisse Romand in a process of it's development;
- to show the importance of the subjective factor to alteration of the language reality;
- to analyze linguistic peculiarities of Suisse Romand at the phonetic, morphological, syntactical and semantic levels.

**Theoretical and practical significance:** This work is relevant because the problem of language picture of the Swiss regional language is not enough represented in Russian and European linguistic works. In practice this work might worth attention of sociolinguist, psycholinguistics and help in

development of country-specific studies of Switzerland.

**Results of research:** As results of the research we have drawn following conclusions:

- The main factor, explaining the difference between language pictures of the word of the French language and the Suisse Romand language is long historical tradition of official languages equality in the eye of the law,
- Subjective factor affected LPW in a process of it's formation.
- The results of the interferences between Suisse Romand and other official languages of Switzerland notice at all the levels of the language.
